Working Papers Series Submission Guidelines

Overview

Working papers are "work-in-progress" versions of research papers, academic articles, or prospective book chapters.

Publishing your work as a working paper allows you to share your research in a citable form before it's completed. Publishing in a peer-reviewed journal is an arduous process that can take several months; publishing in a working paper series is faster, allowing you to get your argument out there while you are still making revisions.

(Publishing in our working paper series does not preclude simultaneous or subsequent publication elsewhere, so long as you maintain the copyrights to your manuscript.)

Our working paper series is hosted on our official website, <u>bulosancenter.ucdavis.edu</u>, and represents one of two avenues through which you can publish your research with us (the other being a peer-reviewed academic journal entitled *Alon*).

Format

Your working paper should have the following:

- A title
- A reasonable 12pt font
- Double-spacing
- Citations (style of your choice)

Beyond that, the form and content of working papers is up to individual authors. There is no length requirement or limit. Submissions will only be lightly edited by our Bulosan Center staff so as to retain the voice and intention of the author.

If your paper is accepted, you will be asked to append a standardized cover page that includes an abstract about your project.

Submission Guidelines

All submissions are reviewed to see if its content aligns with the Center's mission and vision. We will also make minor copyediting suggestions if necessary.

Subject lines for email submissions **must** follow this format: "Bulosan Center Working Paper Series Submission - [Author's Name Here]"

You may submit revised versions of your working paper if you make significant changes to what you have currently published with us.
